## Mission

To coordinate and support the Denver Metro Continuum of Care (CoC) to ensure the most efficient and effective services to reduce homelessness in the seven-county region.

CoC is defined as the collaboration of Stakeholders which have interest in or provide a continuum of services to address homelessness.

The seven counties included in MDHI are Adams, Arapahoe, Boulder, Broomfield, Denver, Douglas and Jefferson.

## Programs

The three main programs of Metropolitan Denver Homeless Initiative include:

### Regional Needs Assessment and Service Planning

Each year MDHI convenes a series of meetings for metropolitan stakeholders to identify local service gaps and metropolitan homeless priorities. Identified priorities are used to develop a comprehensive application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). Since its inception, MDHI has brought in over \$175 million in grants for the Denver metropolitan area.

### Conducting and Disseminating Research

MDHI oversees the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS). MDHI conducts an annual Point-in-Time survey in January and then issues a report which provides the community with current information on the status of homelessness in the Denver metropolitan area.

### Strategic Community Organizing

MDHI's Coordinating Committee works with stakeholders from around the region to implement a coordinated entry and assessment system.
