Mission

The Metro Denver Homeless Initiative (MDHI) coordinates and supports the Metro Denver Continuum of Care (CoC), a multi-agency collaboration focused on reducing homelessness in the seven-county Denver metropolitan area (Adams, Arapahoe, Boulder, Broomfield, Denver, Douglas, and Jefferson counties). The CoC brings together public and private stakeholder organizations to provide a comprehensive array of homelessness prevention activities, housing placement assistance, and related supportive services for persons who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless.

Programs

MDHI carries out its mission through three main activities:

- Regional needs assessment and service planning—Each year, MDHI convenes a series of stakeholder meetings to identify service gaps
 and priorities related to homelessness. The findings are used to develop a comprehensive CoC grant application for submission to the
 U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. Since its inception in 1996, MDHI has secured over \$200 million in grants for the
 Denver metropolitan area.
- Conducting and disseminating research—MDHI oversees the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS), which gathers data on
 assistance provided to homeless persons by CoC participants. Each year, MDHI conducts a Point-in-Time survey of area homelessness and
 issues a report that provides the community with current information on the status of homelessness in the Denver metropolitan area.
- Strategic community organizing—MDHI is working with regional stakeholders to implement a coordinated entry and assessment system
 for homeless persons who seek assistance or are identified through outreach activities.
